## Style Guidelines

- Please submit all work as Word (.doc) documents saved under the contributor's name • Please use New Zealand English spelling
- Please use single quotation marks not double
- Indicate indented paragraphs using only the space bar, not the Tab button

Please note: Atlas will not accept any writing that may compromise the confidentiality and privacy of others.

All work may be published online as well as in print unless specifically requested. Please let us know if you wish for your writing to remain anonymous.

Recommended word limits are as follows:

Short Stories: Up to 2,000 words

Critical Essays: Up to 3,000 words

Poetry: Up to 5 poems per author of any length

## Submissions Process

We will notify you when your submission has been received and hope to get back to you with an indication of whether the submission has been successful within one month. Unfortunately due to the volume of submissions, we may not be able to get back to you with individualised reasons about why your work was not selected for publication.

Writing will then be sent for detailed review by an editorial team. Authors may be asked to revise their writing during this process.

Final selection for publication will be made in conjunction with our editorial board once the review and revision process is completed.

Acceptance of an article into the review process does not constitute a guarantee of publication.
